I have the pleasure of enclosing a packet for you from our mutual Friend Mr. Chandler which I received by the Prince Regent Schooner that returned here from New Zealand on the 29<sup>th</sup> last May and since I have received no further accounts from thence, nor has any conveyance occur'd direct for England until the present opportunity of the Ship Tarcan to sail in a few days.

I have also to enclose the original agreement I entered into with Mr. William Kemmode respecting the Oil and Whale bone which the Brig Active belonging to the Society might procure, of which Vessel's success at the Pursuit for Whale Oil I have received from Capt. Thompson satisfactory account, and who had instructions from me to transmit you the first Set of the Bill for the amount of the Oil &c. delivered on board the Quays in terms of my agreement with Mr. Kemmode, a form of the Bill I sent to Mr. Thompson and in all probability you may receive the first before this comes to hand, as I understand Mr. Kemmode's Vessel proceeds to Liverpool direct from the Boreas.
